The children have been inspired, challenged and have definitely been learning!




Our Nursery children have been exploring mark making with paint this week. They enjoyed getting messy and made some super shapes and lines.




Our reception children have explored many things, such as 'rhyming week', 'children in need' and Remembrance Day. For Remembrance Day, we potato printed poppies.




Our Year 1 children have enjoyed their tinkering activity with the Bee-Bots in computing this week.
