Mobile Library Bus



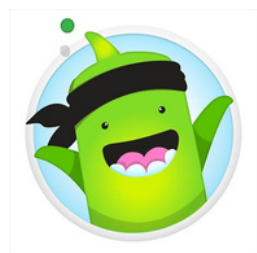

The library cards can be used in any Walsall library.

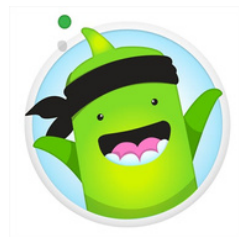

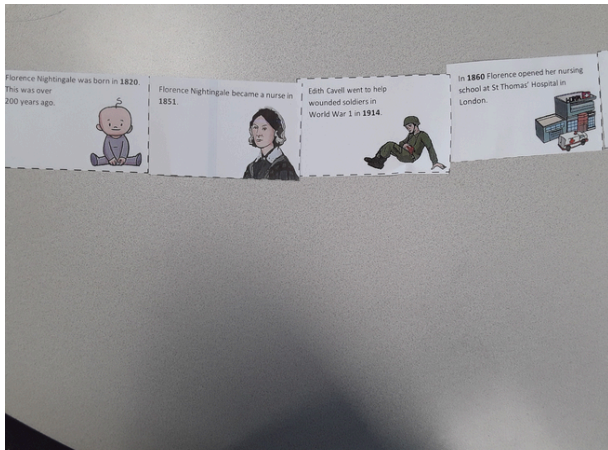
The children have been inspired, challenged and have definitely been learning!



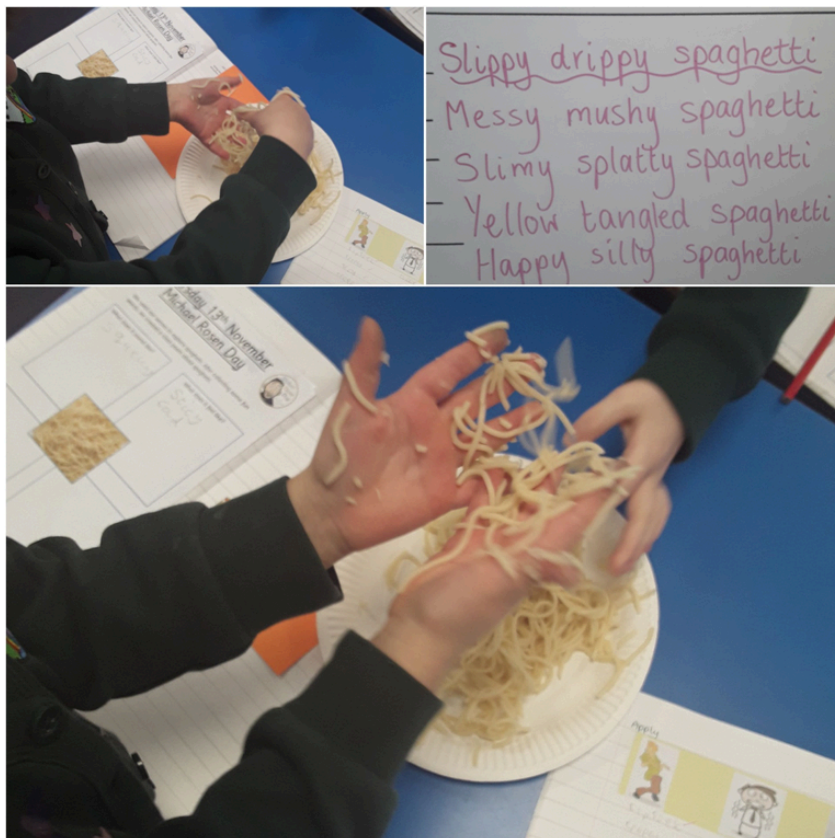
Our Nursery children have been exploring being a good friend and how we can look after each other. They have enjoyed teaching Lola the listening Leopard how to play nicely.



Our reception children have been learning about bears and they've had so much fun exploring different types of bears. The pictures represent the children using their skills to create their own collage bear faces.



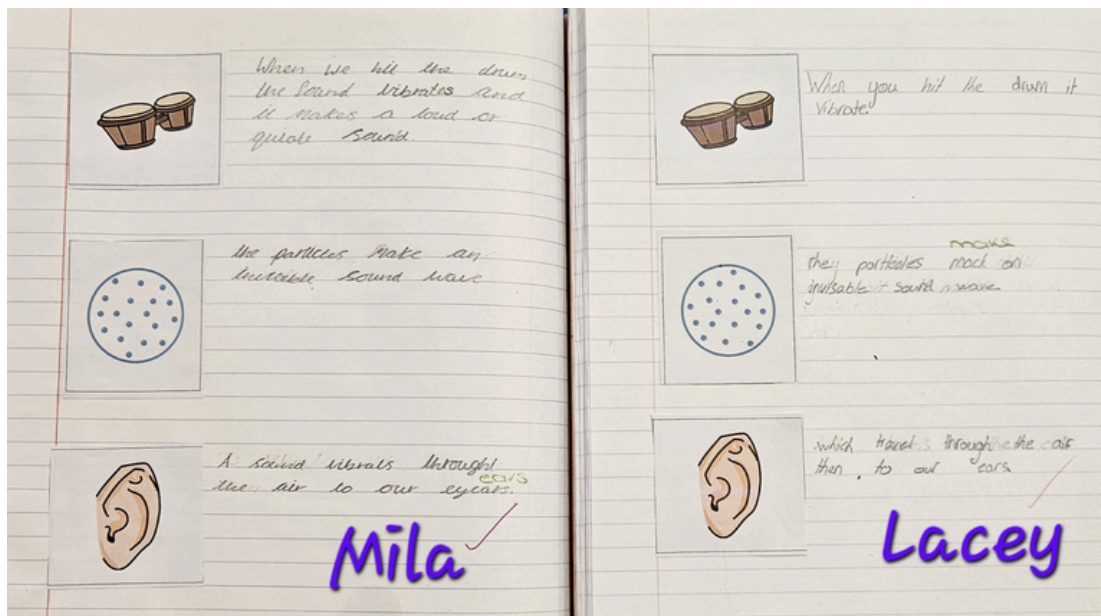
Our Year 1 children have been putting the events in the lives of Florence Nightingale and Edith Cavell, in chronological order.

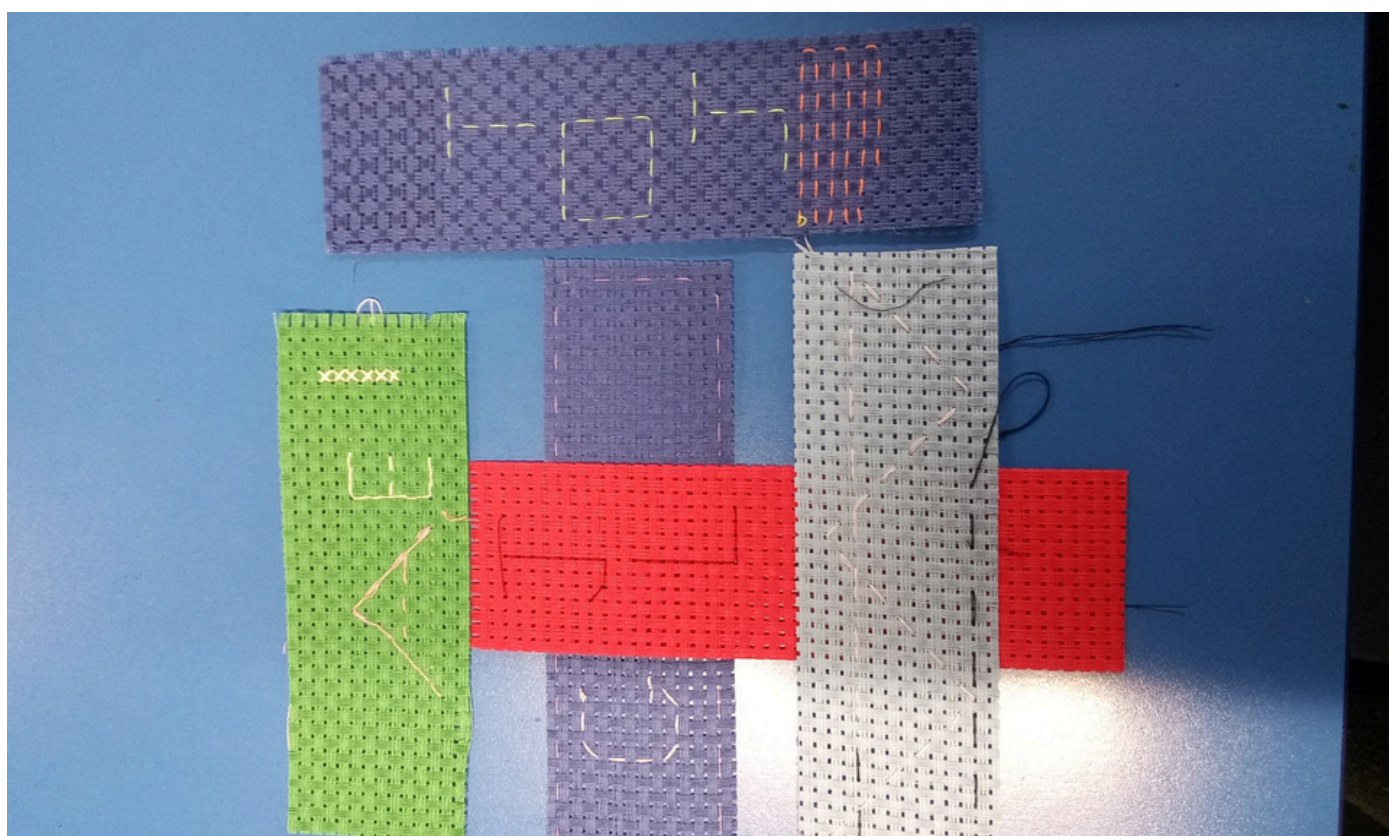
Our Year 3 children have been working really hard on their addition and subtraction. Here they are using bar models and the column method to calculate the answer to the problems.
