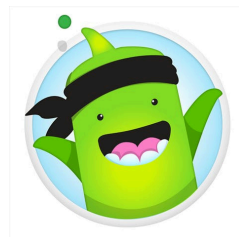

Reception children had fun printing different shades of blue to create the ocean and then chose a blackened sea creature for their silhouette.



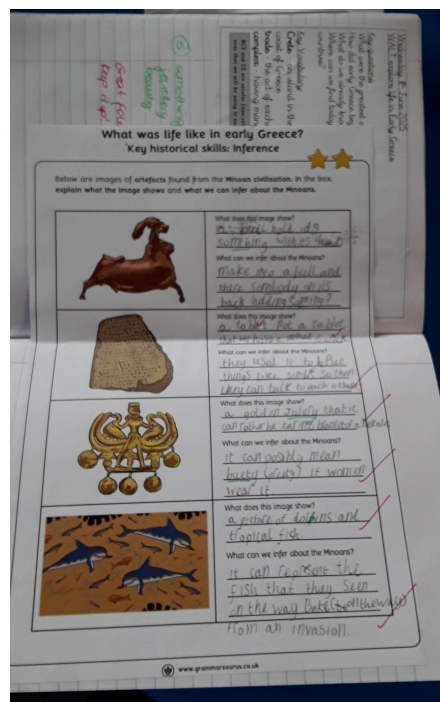
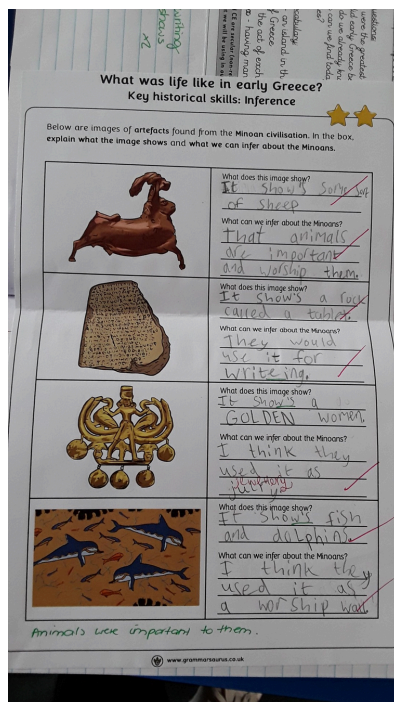
Our Year 1 children have been investigating hand puppets, discussing what they are for and how they think that the puppets are made.



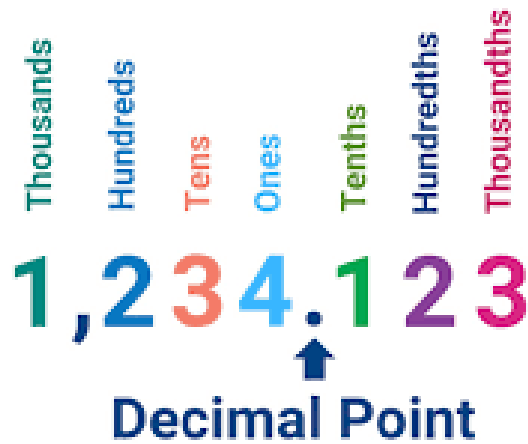
Our Year 2 children have been finding out about habitats around the world.
