The children have been inspired, challenged and have definitely been learning!




Our Nursery children have been making amazing faces. They have learnt all about their emotions to make different types of faces. Happy and loved was their favourite face.








Our reception children have been exploring their emotions through the story: The Colour Monster. Here are some of the children's watercolour monsters, demonstrating different colours for different emotions.




Our Year 1 children have been making numbers using the partwhole model in Maths.









Our Year 2 children have been investigating counting in 3s by making triangle patterns.






Year 3 children have written wonderful non-chronological reports about tortoises this week, showing real enthusiasm for the topic!
