We have to gain parental permission for children to be included in photographs that appear in the local press, with or without names.

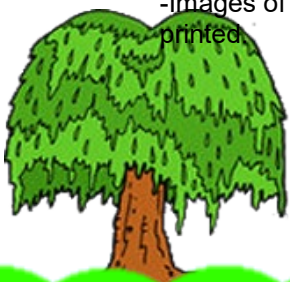
Internet use

In school we have done all we can to ensure that our children do not have access to undesirable images and information on the Internet. We have recently updated security software and a filtered proxy server. The children are taught how to use the internet sensibly and issues such as cyber-bullying are addressed in PSHE sessions.

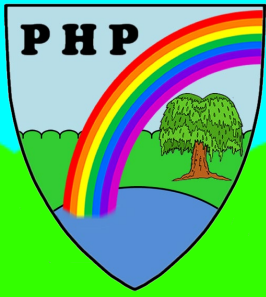
We follow the authority's guidelines on Internet and email privacy and safety:

- Parental permission is required for use of internet and email
- The filtering proxy server may only be disabled by the Headteacher

- Downloading of files is restricted to staff.
- All email will be monitored by the class teacher.
- Any child finding that they are uncomfortable or upset by anything they discover on the net will be reported to the class teacher immediately.
- Children and staff will not reveal any personal details on the internet
- Children will only engage in organised dialogue with other Internet users.
- Images of children will only be put on the website with parental permission; their names will not be printed

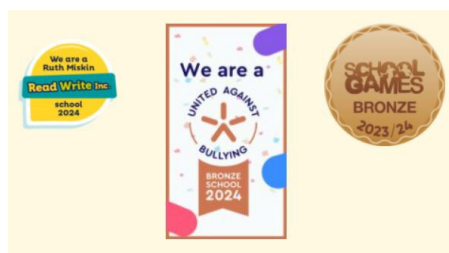
- New requirements for consent, e.g. an additional social media account will be used to share pupil images and videos, or for a press release
